

SCENIC RIM COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE **CHAIR'S SUMMARY**

The seventh meeting of the Scenic Rim Community Consultative Committee was held in Peak Crossing on Thursday, 23 May 2019.

This Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting and ensures that information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting record, the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Mr John Brent in the absence of Ms Kathy Baburin and attended by 11 of the 13 local community representatives, appointed as members of the committee. Six observers attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide an update on the project with specific focus to the status of the Environmental Impact Statement for Calvert to Kagaru.

Presentations were provided by the Calvert to Kagaru (C2K) project team.

- Inland Rail to confirm if Mount Flinders has a visualisation prepared as part of the EIS and advise criteria for visual impact assessment.
- Where are artefacts relocated when found? Which museums?
- What consideration is the project team looking at using plants to hide infrastructure?
- Inland Rail to provide information to CCC on Mental Health Partnership
- ▶ What is the economic impact for businesses?
