



LOCKYER VALLEY COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S SUMMARY

INLAND RAIL

The 6th meeting of the Lockyer Valley Community Consultative Committee was held in Helidon on Tuesday, 11 June 2019. This Chair's summary provides an overview of the Committee meeting and ensures that information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the Committee.

The meeting was chaired by Dr Mark Hohenhaus and attended by 12 of the 14 local community representatives, appointed as members of the Committee.

A total of 33 observers attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide a project update, including the Gowrie to Helidon (G2H) and Helidon to Calvert (H2C) alignments progression. Presentations were provided by the Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) Inland Rail Chief Executive Officer Richard Wankmuller, Inland Rail Public Private Partnership (PPP) Director Tony Lubofsky and project teams.

Information provided to the committee included:

- ▶ An overview of the ARTC Inland Rail project, presented by Mr Wankmuller
- ▶ Brief update on the progress of the PPP, presented by Mr Lubofsky
- ▶ Gowrie to Helidon project update, presented by Max Nichols

- ▶ Helidon to Calvert project update, presented by Chris Matthews
- ▶ Introduction to noise and vibration impacts and visual amenity assessment, presented by Shane Harris

Following the presentations Mr Wankmuller, assisted by the project team, answered a series of project related questions submitted by the committee members over the previous weeks. The questions and answers will be provided with committee minutes and will be available on the Lockyer Valley CCC webpage inlandrail.com.au/lv-ccc

During the course of the meeting, Committee members raised the following actions:

- ▶ Committee to confirm process for circulation of presentations/reports in advance of CCC meetings.
- ▶ Committee confirmed their desire to review the hydrological and other associated EIS studies for G2H as soon as is reasonable.
- ▶ Committee has determined that an additional meeting is required in advance of the H2C draft EIS submission.
- ▶ Committee has requested the Consultation Program for G2H be updated to reflect delays experienced.
- ▶ Committee members to submit three major items/issues for further investigation and presentation by Inland Rail project team over the coming meetings.

- ▶ Inland Rail to confirm the July date for visual amenity workshop, facilitated by Lat27, as soon as reasonable.
- ▶ Committee to nominate representatives to participate in a visual amenity workshop, facilitated by Lat27 on behalf of Inland Rail.

The committee also acknowledged the presentation of a letter of resignation from Mr Ian Rickuss, noting his time and contribution to the committee over the past 18 months.

The next Lockyer Valley CCC meeting is planned to be held in Grantham on Tuesday 13 August 2019. Details of the next meeting will be advertised on the ARTC website, to ensure those who would like to attend have that opportunity.
