

The 8th meeting of the Lockyer Valley Community Consultative Committee was held in Postmans Ridge on Tuesday, 15 October 2019.

This Chair's Summary provides an overview of the Committee meeting and ensures that information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the Committee.

The meeting was chaired by Dr Mark Hohenhaus and attended by 8 of the 12 local community representatives, appointed as members of the Committee. A total of 17 observers attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide a project update, including the Helidon to Calvert (H2C) and Gowrie to Helidon (G2H) feasibility design progression. Presentations were provided by the Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) Inland Rail project team.

Information provided to the Committee included:

- ▶ Gowrie to Helidon project update, presented by Environment Advisor G2H, Michael Price including the launch of the interactive map, upcoming community information sessions and alignment update
- ▶ Gowrie to Helidon draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) topic update, presented by Environment Advisor G2H, Michael Price
- ▶ Helidon to Calvert project update, presented by Project Manager H2C, Chris Matthews
- ▶ social impacts and opportunities update, presented by Helen Williams, Social Performance Principal Qld
- ▶ property update, presented by Amanda Reed, Property Manager QLD.

The Committee acknowledged Mr Linton Brimblecombe's resignation, as presented to the Chair, due to work commitments. The Committee also acknowledged the pending review of the CCC as per the Charter, noting this as an item of business for the next ordinary meeting.
