Planning Assessment Process

- ARTC lodged an application for the North Star to Border project on 23 May 2018
- DPIE issued SEARs on 8 August 2018 and reissued to include borrow sites on 13 March 2020
- DPIE has undertaken consistency review of draft EIS and provided comments to ARTC
- ARTC will finalise the EIS and lodge it to DPIE



Exhibition

- EIS exhibited for a minimum of 28 days
- Exhibited on DPIE's Major Projects website
- Physical copies and newspaper advertising affected by Covid-19 restrictions
- Anyone may make a written submission
- These need to be made online on DPIE's Major Projects website



Consultation

- DPIE will consult with Councils and Government departments
- Consultation on key assessment issues and impacts
- DPIE will also consult with community stakeholders
- Considering best way to do that in current environment



Assessment and Determination

- DPIE publishes submissions on website and provides to ARTC
- ARTC prepares Response to Submissions (RtS) and (if applicable) Amendment Report
- These are published on Major Projects website
- DPIE considers submissions and RtS and finalises assessment
- Application determined by Minister for Planning and Public Spaces
