



In March 2018, ARTC awarded the Phase 2 contract to IRDJV (WSP-Mott McDonald Joint Venture)


PRIOR ACTIONS



- 1. 2016-2017 2km wide corridor
- 2. June 2018 SSI application
 - Resulted in definition of SEARS
- 3. Reference design and EIS commenced March 2018
 - IRDJV
- 4. 250m Focused Area of Investigation (FAI) announced 30 June 2019

CURRENT STATUS



1. Reference design and alignment selection substantially advanced

2. Ongoing refinement led to:

- Value engineering/optimisation exercise
- Improve value for money
- ▶ Without unacceptably compromising service levels, environmental impacts, stakeholder or other impacts

3. Optimisation focused on:


- ▶ Review of grade of the alignment
- Road/rail interfaces (bridges and level crossings)
- Connections at each end of I2S

WHAT NEXT



- 1. Completion of Optimisation in 2-3 months
- 2. Update and finalisation of Reference Design to incorporate changes (if any)
- 3. Update and finalise the EIS based on the update Reference Design
- 4. EIS Approval Q3/Q4 2021
- 5. Select Design and Construct Construction Contractor Q4 2021
- 6. Construction complete Q3 2024

CONSULTATION FAST FACTS



- Met more than 800 community members at regional shows
- Held 15 community information sessions and met with 455 community members
- Emailed and sent project information to over
 770 community members
- Hosted over 300 face-to-face meetings including group meetings
- Completed over 140 site investigations
- Attended four Community Consultative Committee (CCC) meetings

CONSULTATION NEXT STEPS



Next steps:

- A comprehensive round of engagement will be conducted upon receipt of an updated reference design
 - Currently expected September 2020
- ▶ Engagement will include:
 - MPs and government agencies
 - impacted landowners
 - wider community
 - special interest groups, including industry and local chambers of commerce
- Stakeholder feedback will be collated and provided to design team for consideration into the updated reference design
- Following this, our next round of community consultation will be for the draft EIS, currently anticipated for first-half of 2021
