

Narromine to Narrabri drop-in and online sessions

You are invited to drop into a community information session or join us online to find out more about the proposed Narromine to Narrabri rail corridor.

Narromine to Narrabri is the longest of Inland Rail's 13 projects and involves the construction of 306km of new track.

When complete, Inland Rail will better link North West NSW businesses, producers and manufacturers to national and global markets, and generate new opportunities for industries and regions.

We have now refined the 150m to 400m wide Focused Area of Investigation to a 40m to 60m wide proposed rail corridor.

This is an important milestone for both the project and the community, and we invite you to come meet the team and find out the latest.
