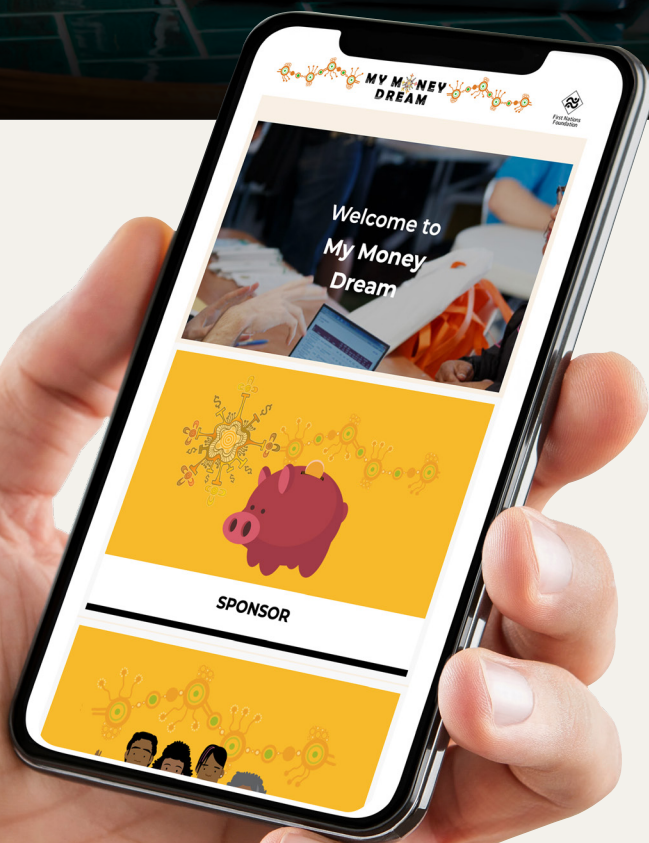

My Money Dream - a free financial literacy program

We are committed to helping individuals build life-long skills and prosperity within their local communities through the Inland Rail Skills Academy. In partnership with Indigenous charity First Nations Foundation and our Narrabri to North Star-Phase 1 contractor Trans4m Rail, we are empowering our Indigenous workforce and their families to take control of their personal finances through a culturally safe, free financial literacy program.

If you're an Indigenous person working on Narrabri to North Star-Phase 1, you're invited to sign up for My Money Dream.

What is My Money Dream?

My Money Dream is an app designed by Indigenous people, for Indigenous people. It is designed to help users take control of their financial future and encourage their communities to do the same. This online program has been used successfully by more than 1000 Indigenous people over the past 10 years. My Money Dream will help you learn about managing your money, from budgeting to banking, superannuation to insurance.

How does it work?

If you sign up to My Money Dream, you get free access to the My Money Dream app and dedicated support from My Money Dream to help with both technical challenges and money related questions. We are keen to hear about your experience using the My Money Dream app, so we will check in with you halfway through and at the end of the program to learn how My Money Dream worked for you.

First Nations Foundation (FNF) is a majority Indigenous-operated not-for-profit organisation. FNF has a proven track record of results, a strong relationship with Indigenous communities throughout Australia, and is striving to have more Indigenous people participate in the financial services sector.
