



## Chair's summary

## Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee

The seventeenth meeting of the Scenic Rim and Ipswich Community Consultative Committee (CCC) was held both in person at the Ipswich Civic Centre and online on **Thursday**, **5 May 2022**.

This Chair's summary provides an overview of the committee meeting regarding the Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) Inland Rail Calvert to Kagaru (C2K) Project. This summary is a precursor to the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Ms Kathy Baburin, and attended by seven representatives appointed as members of the committee. Four apologies were received by committee members. Seven observers attended the meeting and eight observers attended online, totalling 15 observers.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide information on ARTC Inland Rail's mental health and Social Performance activities, including Indigenous Participation programs. A sustainability presentation was also provided.
